You can review with your insurer that you have coverage for DME or verify that you have coverage for Prosthetic and Orthotic devices.

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MyoPro™ is a custom, portable, light-weight, functional arm brace that assists with movement of a weak arm as a result of neuromuscular damage. The brace incorporates established non-invasive myoelectric sensing in a customized, wearable brace that enables a person to initiate and control movement of their own arm.

The MyoPro custom arm brace does not use electrical stimulation and relies on the user's own muscle signal to move their arm.



Sensors in the brace detect weak muscle signals, which power the motor to move the arm in the desired direction. The user is completely controlling their own arm; the brace simply amplifies the user's weak muscle signal to help bend and move the arm. With the brace, a user is able to stabilize themselves to safely perform activities of daily living such as feeding, reaching, and lifting.
